

Byelaw 2 – Union policy

2.1. Setting Policy

Union Policy may be set by members via the democratic processes of the Union at either;

1. Student Council
2. General Meetings
3. Referendum

2.2 Overturning Policy

1. The Board of Trustees has the right to overturn any policy decision set via the democratic processes if the policy;
 - a. Has serious financial implication for the Union
 - b. Fails to comply with law or the charitable aims of the Union
 - c. Is likely to damage the reputation of the Union
2. The decision of the Board of Trustees in these matters shall be final

2.3 Policy Register

1. The SU President will maintain a Policy register which is available to any full member, trustee or employee of the Union.
2. The SU President will advise Student Council of Policies which will lapse in the following month.

2.4 Amendments

Policies may be amended by a resolution of Student Council provided this is not within the same academic year that the policy was adopted.

2.5 Policy Lapse

1. Policy shall automatically lapse:
 - a. After 3 years
 - b. In the event it contravenes or contradicts any law, Article or Byelaw of the Union
