

Byelaw 2 – Union policy

2.1. Setting Policy

Union Policy may be set by members via the democratic processes of the Union at either;

- 1. Student Council
- 2. General Meetings
- 3. Referendum

2.2 Overturning Policy

- 1. The Board of Trustees has the right to overturn any policy decision set via the democratic processes if the policy;
 - a. Has serious financial implication for the Union
 - b. Fails to comply with law or the charitable aims of the Union
 - c. Is likely to damage the reputation of the Union
- 2. The decision of the Board of Trustees in these matters shall be final

2.3 Policy Register

- 1. The SU President will maintain a Policy register which is available to any full member, trustee or employee of the Union.
- 2. The SU President will advise Student Council of Policies which will lapse in the following month.

2.4 Amendments

Policies may be amended by a resolution of Student Council provided this is not within the same academic year that the policy was adopted.

2.5 Policy Lapse

- 1. Policy shall automatically lapse:
 - a. After 3 years
 - b. In the event it contravenes or contradicts any law, Article or Byelaw of the Union
