

Byelaw 13 – External affiliations

13.1 External affiliations

All external affiliations and continuation to affiliate must be decided by a cross campus secret ballot, in accordance with the Education Act 1994, Section 22.

13.2 Continued External Affiliations

- 1. Members may call a referenda to determine the continuation to an external affiliation. Such referenda shall only be called when;
 - a. Requested to do so by a signed petition of 150 full members; or
 - b. After 3 years of the date the last vote on the affiliation was held.
- 2. A referenda on any one external affiliation can only be called once per academic year.
- 3. The referenda will only be valid if at least 300 full members vote, otherwise, the issue shall be put to the next General Meeting where a secret ballot vote will be held.
- 4. The Trustees may appoint a returning officer, and allocate funds as they see fit.
- 5. As far as possible, the referendum should comply with Byelaw 6 , the regulations for Elections.
