WHAT ARE SOLENT BY-ELECTIONS?

WHAT IS A VOLUNTEER OFFICER?

A Volunteer Officer is an elected student who represents the views of student groups, while continuing with their studies. WHAT IS A SCHOOL REP?

If you're not happy with any of the candidates running in the election for a specific role, you can vote to re-open nominations aka R.O.N.






LGBT+ STUDENTS' OFFICER

Champion opportunities that showcase our talent.


